Alberta Occupational Health and Safety: Representative from OH and S met with CAO on Wednesday July 25, 2018 regarding safe work practices within the Village of Donalda. Follow up meeting was on Monday July 30, 2018 with PW Foreman Ramstad and Beth Fulton from Donalda Ag Society. Recommendations and reporting will be reviewed with OH and S representatives regarding safe work practices for all Village employees including summer students. New work practices and procedures will be implemented to ensure the Village of Donalda is compliant with legislation.

<u>Water Standpipe Rehabilitation:</u> Coating of interior and exterior of Water Standpipe has been completed by the contractor. Water operators from Stettler County have filled the standpipe and is now back online for the water distribution system.

<u>Cannabis Legislation:</u> GRA-CORE Consulting has been invited to review Village of Donalda Land Use Bylaw for cannabis legislation and recommendations and verification of Council regarding retail and production of cannabis. This process is in conjunction of creating a new Municipal Development Plan for the Village of Donalda.

<u>Muniware Software Training:</u> Administration arranged for day training for the office software with the addition of new staff member Andrea Benoit. Muniware representative attended Village Office on July 23, 2018 for training day on various topics.

<u>ATB Banking:</u> Administration has made changes with all Village Banking Accounts now interest bearing and no service charges. Administration can now invest grant funding to earn interest on funds received.

<u>Stettler County Water and Wastewater Operators:</u> Administration is working with County Administration on a water/wastewater contract and outline for services from Stettler County.

<u>Alberta Municipal Affairs Interviews:</u> Interviews were conducted on July 25, 2018 for Administration and Council with Alberta Municipal Affairs staff regarding petition produced for the Village of Donalda. Final report will be coming from Alberta Municipal Affairs.

<u>Morkshop:</u> Workshop hosted by Stettler County on July 26, 2018 with Alberta Urban Municipalities Association for neighboring municipalities to explore intermunicipal agreements as per legislation. CAO Olson has met with Stettler County and has draft IDP documents being reviewed before being presented to Council.
