In this Bylaw unless the context otherwise requires

- 2 S.A. 1994, C.F.-18.5 "Act" means the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act,
- 6 "Applicant" means a person who makes a request for access to a record under Section 7(1) of the Act,
- C and District Museum Board, Donalda and District Seniors Board, Donalda are appointed or chosen by the Village of Donalda including the Stettler owned by the Village of Donalda and all the members or officers of which committee, commission, panel, agency, or corporation that is created or "Village" means the Village of Donalda and includes any board Cemetery Board and Stettler and District Ambulance Association Stettler Housing Authority, Donalda Municipal Library Board, Donalda Donalda and District Family Community Support Services, County of Recreational Board, but does not include the Stettler Fire Commission, Waste Management Authority and the County of Stettler Regional
- 0 who holds the position of Village Administrator in an Acting Capacity. Administrative Officer of the Village of Donalda and includes any person "Village Administrator" means the person appointed as the Chief
- e) "Province" means the Province of Alberta.

Interpretation

PART 2 - DESIGNATED HEAD

For the purpose of the Act, the Village Administrator is designated as the Head of the Village of Donalda.

PART 3 - FEES

Where an applicant is required to pay a fee for services, the fee payable is accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulation, AR 200/95, as amended from time to time or any successor Regulation that sets fees for request for Information from the Province

PART 4 - GENERAL
