

VILLAGE OF DONALDA

BYLAW #648

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF DONALDA IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE OF DONALDA TO TAKE THE NECESSARY ACTION TO ESTABLISH A REGIONAL WATER SERVICES COMMISSION.

WHEREAS the Village of Donalda wishes to participate in the establishment of a regional water services commission pursuant to Part 15.1 of the *Municipal Government Act* (R.S.A. 2004, c. M-26 as amended);

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the power conferred upon it by the *Municipal Government Act*, the Council of the Village of Donalda, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

SECTION 1

SHORT TITLE

1. This by-law shall be known and may be cited as the “**Regional Water Services Commission Authorization Bylaw**” of the Village of Donalda.

SECTION 2

REGIONAL WATER SERVICES COMMISSION

2. The Council of the Village of Donalda is hereby authorized to make any necessary Agreements and take the necessary action together with the Council of any other Municipality or Municipalities for the establishment of a regional water services commission pursuant to Part 15.1 of the *Municipal Government Act*.
