Repeal of Obsolete and Outdated Bylaws

A Bylaw in the Village of Donalda, in the province of Alberta, to repeal obsolete, expired, outdated, spent or otherwise ineffective Bylaws passed previously by the Village of Donalda;

WHEREAS section 63(1)(b) of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26 Revised Status of Alberta 2000, a council may authorize the revision of all or any of the municipality's bylaws. The bylaw may authorize the following: omit, without providing for its repeal, a bylaw or a provision of a bylaw that is of transitional nature or that refers only to a particular place, person, or thing that has no general application throughout the municipality;

WHEREAS, the Village of Donalda wishes to repeal Bylaws that are inoperable, obsolete, expired, or otherwise spent or ineffective;

1. BYLAW TITLE

1.1 The bylaw shall be referred to as the Repeal of Obsolete and Outdated Bylaws No. 742/21.
