BYLAW NO. 748-21

This is a bylaw of the Village of Donalda to authorize the execution of a Master Agreement between the Village of Donalda and other municipalities for the establishment of an intermunicipal planning agency.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act* allows a municipality to enter into an agreement with other municipalities for the performance of any matter or thing judged to be of benefit to them;

AND WHEREAS the VIllage of Donalda considers it beneficial to enter into an agreement with certain other municipalities for the provision of land use planning services.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the VIllage of Donalda in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Master Agreement establishing an intermunicipal service agency, to be known as Parkland Community Planning Services, a copy of which is attached hereto, is hereby ratified and approved; and the Mayor and the Chief Administrative Officer are hereby authorized to execute the said agreement for and on behalf of the VIllage of Donalda.
- 2. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon third reading.
