



The 2023 Taxes have been distributed and the deadline for payment is July 2, 2023. If you have any questions or concerns, or would like to join the Monthly Tax Installment Plan, please contact the Village Office. Administration are more than happy to explain anything you may not understand.

I appreciate the passion that the residents of the Village of Donalda have for our vibrant community, and we, as the council, love to hear feedback from our residents to ensure we are governing in the best interest of our citizens. If you have any concerns regarding Village Business, please contact the Village Office or a member of Council, rather than posting on Social Media, as this only serves to agitate the situation, and leads to misinformation. The Regular Meeting of Council if held every third Tuesday of the month, and everyone is welcome to attend.

As stated in the previous edition of the Donalda Lite, the Standpipe has been decommissioned due to a critical infrastructure failure. While residents will not see an interruption in their drinking water, it does affect the Village's ability to support fire suppression through the use of the Village's fire hydrants. The Regional Fire Department is aware of the hydrants being out of service in the Village, as are the Village's Mutual Aid Partners. The Village's engineering firm is investigating a remediation plan for the Village's Standpipe to return it temporarily to working order, before constructing an underground reservoir and pumphouse as a long-term solution in 2024.


