

Franchise Fee Increase Notice

Please be advised the Village of Donalda is proposing to increase the local franchise fee, which is charged to ATCO Electric for use of the municipal lands for its power lines effective January 1, 2024. The fee is recovered by ATCO Electric from its customers that receive electric service in the Village of Donalda.

The franchise fee will be increased from 12% to 12.5% on the delivery charge of ATCO Electric excluding energy related riders. The average residential increase has been estimated at \$0.62 per month based on the average consumption of 625kWh.

MAYOR'S MESSAGE

First, a big thank you to Cody McKay for running the Donalda Transfer Site. The place is run efficiently and is well organized.

Fire Update: The Village's exit from the Regional Fire Authority has been extended to June 30, 2024, to allow for the County of Stettler to have sufficient time to present the Village with a proposal for consideration.

The annual ongoing funding received by the Village in 2023 through streams other than municipal taxation, as outlined in a recent correspondence by the Honourable Rick McIver, include:

Municipal Sustainability Initiative - Capital \$62,604

Municipal Sustainability Initiative - Operating \$72,712

Canadian Community Building Fund - \$50,000

Finally, as reported in the May 2023 Donalda Lite, the Alberta Water Waste Water Partnership grant awarded the Village of Donalda \$2,975,000 to construct an underground reservoir and pumphouse, the Honourable Devin Dreeshen reported. Currently, this project is in the planning and development stage with Select Engineering. The Planning and Development of this proposed project appeared on the Village's 2023 Capital Budget. Once the engineering firm has provided the Village with all the necessary information to decide on the project, the Village Council will host an information session with its residents.


