To the Residents of the Village of Donalda

Summer passes so quickly! This means that the new school year is about to begin and our children will be on the streets morning and afternoon travelling to and from school. Please drive on the streets with caution so that the kids are safe. The speed limit in the Village on all streets and at all times is 30km/hr. From time to time the RCMP are in our Village and will be observing speeds and will issue tickets when necessary. The next Village Council meeting will be held on September 18, 2018. It will be held in a facility larger than the library, possibly the Drop-Inn Center. Please watch for further notice confirming this location. This meeting will start at **6.00 pm**. This will allow for an informational open house on upcoming Cannabis legislation prior to the regular Council meeting which will commence at **7.00 pm**. At the August Council Meeting an amendment to the Village's Land Use By-Law was introduced and given first reading. This amendment specifies the requirements for the retail sale of Cannabis within the Village. Any amendment to a Land Use By-Law requires a Public Hearing. This Public Hearing will be held within the regular Council Meeting on September 18. After this Hearing the regular Council Meeting will resume and Council will consider introducing the amendment for second and third readings. Prior to this meeting copies of the proposed amendment to the Village Land Use By-Law are available at the Village Office. All elected Municipal Officials are required to be placed under Oath. In doing so they become qualified to act as a Commissioner of Oaths. Your Village Councilors all have the official Commissioning Stamps and are available to provide Commissioning Services on request. Our next regular meeting is **Tuesday, September 11** at 7:30pm at the Arena Lobby. New members are always welcome and directors are needed.


