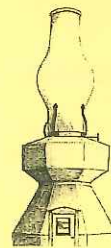

## FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY

attended the March 14th meeting and the consensus was to  
formally establish a "Friends of the Library Society" The  
primary purpose of which is to generate an on going source  
of revenue to supplement existing government funding.  
Council "expressly" stated at the their March 20 meeting  
that the present level of municipal funding ( approximately  
\$10,000 /yr.) is excess of other areas based on population  
size and is not sustainable. The onus is on the Library and it's

government spending. The purpose of the April meeting is to  
elect an executive: Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Secretary,

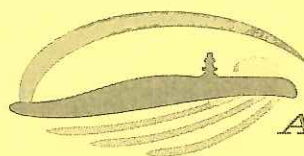

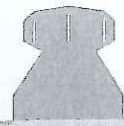
