VILLAGE OF DONALDA

The Village Office has received concerns over the cat population in Donalda and pet owners not spaying or neutering their pets. This has become an issue in the Village. Village of Donalda Bylaw #700 states cats that are not neutered are subject to a \$100.00 fine per animal per offence. It is the pet owners responsible to neuter

their cats to ensure they do not add to the stray population of Donalda. Bylaw complaints are accepted at the Village Office and are completely anonymous. Bylaw complaints are reviewed, and fines will be levied against property owners. We are fortunate to have groups such as Donalda Animal Rescue that volunteer funds and time to try and curb the problem, but the responsibility is squarely on the pet owners to control the population through spaying or neutering their pets.

Utility Accounts are changing for **August 1**, 2018, all properties including vacant lots will now be responsible for utility charges. All inactive accounts including vacant lots will now see utility charges as per "Schedule A" in Utility Bylaw #703 in the Village of Donalda. These properties will now receive a monthly utility bill from the Village of Donalda.


