FROM THE VILLAGE OFFICE

We trust that everyone is having a safe warm winter season and would like to remind you of the following:

Garbage Pick up

Please remember as per the mail outs sent to all residents, that the company we contract our garbage collection to will only pick up your garbage at the curb until further notice. This is due to the icy situation in the alleys. Please note that upon speaking to "Can Pak", we have been advised they are doing this in all the municipalities, including Stettler and bigger centers, since their trucks are getting stuck everywhere they pick up in the alleys.

Dog Licenses

As per Bylaw #650 - "Village Dog Control Bylaw" Licensing of Dog Part 2 states:

A resident of Donalda who is the owner of any Dog aged twelve
 weeks or older shall obtain a license for the Dog from the office of the Village of Donalda as per schedule "B"

2. The Owner of every Dog shall annually, on or before January 31 of each calendar year, renew the license for that dog by submitting to the Village the annual licensing fee as set out in Schedule "B", along with any other information required by the Village. A license shall be valid only for the year for which it was issued, regardless of the actual date upon which the license was purchased.

February, 2014

3. Every Owner shall provide the Dog with a collar to which the Owner shall affix the Tag for such Dog and the Owner shall ensure that the collar and Tag are worn during those occasions when the Dog is no on the owners premises.

As per Schedule "B"

Dog licenses are due to be renewed by January 31 with the price as follows:

Before January 31, 2014

Non - spay, non- neutered - \$40.00 per animal Spay or neutered - \$20.00 per animal

After January 31, 2014

Non- spay, non neutered - \$50.00 per animal Spay or neutered - \$30.00 per animal Lost Tags can be replaced for a fee of \$10.00

Tags are not transferrable.

The entire Bylaw can be viewed upon request at the Village Office, and is also on the village website at www.village.dondalda.ab.ca. Please note: Since the notice for Dog licensing was not in the December Lite, the Village will extend the regular fee deadline until February 15 at 5:30 p.m.

Utility Rates in the Village

As you are aware the Village will be connecting to the Shirley McClellan water system towards the end of March or beginning of April of this year in an endeavor to ensure a more reliable source of water to the village. This decision was made in 2005.

The water will now be metered, as well there are additional charges to the Village for repayment of the debenture and administrative charges that the Village shares with the other entities which are connected to this service. The rate for water will increase \$20.00 per household per. month, starting in March, to begin to offset these additional charges to the Village.

Each resident can help to keep these costs down by making sure your taps or toilets are not dripping or running in excess, and by placing water saving devices on your shower heads or toilets.

Your Village Council, Office and Public works department are working together with the help of Government Capital Grants to continue this year, our refurbishing of the Water Tower, curb stops and water distribution system within the Village to ensure everything is working as efficiently as possible.

We appreciate your patience through this process and thank you for doing your part to help us conserve water.

I would like to thank everyone for being patient with me in regards to the village roads. The village tractor was in the shop getting some minor repair.

The month of January has been a busy month I have attended two meetings in regards to the new waterline coming to Donalda. Also, Council meeting and going over capital projects so we can get tenders out and get some infrastructure work done first thing this spring.

Each day I do a water report for Alberta environment. This report considers of water usage, chlorine concentration and chlorine residual as well as location of where test was done; plus time. On Tuesday, I take a bacterial sample that is sent to the provincial lab. The results are sent to both the Alberta environment and village of Donalda. I can send the results electronically, daily, or compile the information and send in monthly, but there must be a report for each working day.

I am now taking the 2013 year water report, compiling all that information into a historic data sheet with all the highs and lows averages etc. then that is sent to Alberta environment for their review.

Donalda School News Home of the Donalda Eagles Submitted by Beth Fulton





The next parent council meeting will be February 11 at 3:45 at the school library. All parents and the public are welcome to attend.


Donalda School Playground Update
