#### FROM THE VILLAGE OFFICE

We would like to offer a "Huge Congratulations" to the Donalda School Parent Association for their great work fundraising and putting together the new playground at the Donalda School. Also, to all the volunteers who came out to help with the first phase of the three day installation. Great job!!

As you are no doubt aware the Village of Donalda is now live with the Shirley McClellan water system and other then two water leaks, which have been repaired quickly due to Cat Brothers being in the Village, things seem to be running well.

As you are also aware, this contractor is working on and completing many of our Capital projects in the Village for this year. So far with the supervision and expertise of our foreman, Frank Sutton and Select Engineering we have been able to locate and bring up to grade all of our gate valves and manholes. The final water looping from Bond Street East and Railway Avenue, to Haviland Street and Railway Avenue has been completed, the line has been sanitized and final flushing and pressure tests are currently being done. By the end of the week we are anticipating that this line will be live.

The water tower/stand pipe has been inspected by Stantec Engineering and we will be getting their recommendations regarding repairs that need to be done. We still have a fire hydrant to install at that site; otherwise we have completed the replacement of two fire hydrants, one on Haviland Street and Alberta Ave, and one on Lawson Street and Lee Ave. A relocation of one hydrant at the corner of Bond Street East and Railway Ave and installation of new hydrant at the end

of the water looping at Haviland and Railway Avenue. We have also completed a rehabilitation of a section of the sanitary sewer line in the north alley of Haviland.

In the month of September we will be continuing to rehabilitate curb stops, completing another sanitary sewer line rehabilitation as well as other capital projects. Thank you for your continued patience as we work to improve the infrastructure in the Village.

The Village is grateful for the grant funding from Alberta
Transportation and the Municipal Services Infrastructure Capital
Grants we have received that make these projects possible.
We are grateful also to the foresight and planning of Donalda Village
Council.

The Drop-In is open every Saturday afternoon at 1:30 pm - 4:00 pm for coffee and fellowship. Everyone welcome!


#### **Donalda Community Art Society**
