If you have been in to visit us in the Village Office in April you may have noticed someone new. Gwen Wood is joining us to fill in for Janet when she is away for seeding and will continue to help us in the office 2 days a week, while Janet cuts back to 1 day per week. We are happy to have Gwen join us.

Another month has flown by and it looks like things are drying up enough for the Garbage pick-up to return to the back alley. So, please note that Canpak will officially begin picking up garbage in the Alley today, Thursday May 1, 2014.

We have now completed the Tender process and a contractor has been engaged, we are anticipating this work beginning at the end of May for a large portion of the Capital projects that we will be working to complete this year in the Village.

- c) Placement of new Street Name Signage.

Once everything is hooked up, all of the water lines are flushed out and everything is working fine, we will be installing water meters at each residence. 
