DONALDA AB has some wonderful geography to offer to visitors and residents. The hiking trail connects Donalda with 129 acres of land to the north of the village. You can see some great views from the rim of the coulees and can walk from the top to the bottom of the badlands. Visitors will see signage along Railway Ave. directing them to the parking area and the beginning of the trail. The trailhead is located just north of the railway station which is just north of the World's largest oil lamp. The trail begins initially on village property. The first fence line indicates private property and there is a walk thru gate. We ask people to keep to the trail on the private property. Occasionally cows are grazing and this part of the trail can still be used but with caution. An alternate route is to follow the old rail bed, either from the trailhead or follow the path between the cabins to the old rail bed.
