

**BY-LAW #606
VILLAGE OF DONALDA**

Being a bylaw of the Village of Donalda, in the Province of Alberta, to make provision for an E9-1-1 service.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.S., 1994, Chapter M-26.1 and amendments thereto, a municipality may pass bylaws for the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property and for the provision of services by the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Council for the Village of Donalda deems it desirable to provide an Enhanced 9-1-1 Emergency Service (E9-1-1 Service) for the safety, health, welfare and general benefit of the citizens of the Village;

AND WHEREAS the City of Red Deer is able to provide such service to the Village of Donalda at a reasonable cost;

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DONALDA, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "E9-1-1 Bylaw".
2. The Village of Donalda is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Red Deer for the purpose of providing E9-1-1 service to the citizens of the Village of Donalda. The terms of such agreement shall be in accordance with the agreement submitted to Council dated December 5, 1996.
3. This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect on third reading.
