

In 2023, a non-profit society called Donalda Valley Club was formed. Directors are Becky Halseth, President, Gail Charles, Secretary, Virginia Laforge, Treasurer, Brenda Gebhardt, Mary Mueller, Byron Norman and Doreen Hay. Donalda Valley Club's mission statement is to fundraise and provide governance and support to a variety of community projects and initiatives. Currently, the Donalda Valley Club hosts a horse clinic, and two annual trail rides that depart from Donalda.

- -Willy Bronze Trail Ride- held in late September. Proceeds are progressing towards a bronze statue of our world-famous steer wrestling horse.
- -Roberta Rouse-Mothers Trail ride on Mother's Day. Roberta, a single mother working full time at Olds College, was integral in the success of each Willy Bronze ride with her endless positive energy and volunteer hours. She was actively involved in many aspects of the Donalda community before her passing at the peak of her life.
